CITY INTRODUCES NEW O'HARE CONCESSIONS CONTRACTS

Mayor Richard M. Daley today introduced three new concessions contracts for O'Hare International Airport.

"Our goal is to provide air travelers with great food and quality merchandise at a reasonable price," said Mayor Daley. "We want to enhance the experience of travelers coming through O'Hare Airport."

The agreements include McDonald's, Nuance Group and America's Dog for locations throughout the domestic terminals at O'Hare.

- McDonald's is recognized as one of the world's best known brands and has set the industry standard for delivering high quality products and customer service. The new agreement includes four locations, two each in Terminals 1 and 3.
- Nuance Group is the world's largest travel and duty free retailer with 340 travel retail shops in 57 international airports located in 17 countries around the world. These stores offer travelers a variety of high quality products including souvenirs, cosmetics, apparel, jewelry, liquor and timepieces. The agreement includes four locations, two in Terminal 1, one in Terminal 2 and one in Terminal 3.
- America's Dog specializes in hot dogs topped with condiments and ingredients found in America's regionally diverse culinary heritage. In addition, they offer fresh salads, wraps and a breakfast menu. America's Dog will operate in Terminal 1.

The Chicago Airport System has received numerous awards including: "Best Airport in North America" by Business Traveler's magazine for the eighth consecutive year, "Best Redeveloped Concession Program" and "Most Innovative Services" by Airport Revenue News, and first place in best airports offering healthy food choices by the Physicians Committee for Responsible Medicine.
