# O'Hare, Midway to open cell phone lots

June 5, 2006 (CHICAGO) - Starting today, motorists waiting to pick up friends or relatives at Chicago's airports will no longer have to drive in circles or pay for parking.

Both O'Hare and Midway Airports are opening "cell phone lots." Motorists can park in the lots and wait for passengers to give them a call after their plane touches down and they retrieve their baggage. The drivers can then pull up to the arrivals lane.

The O'Hare cell phone lot opening today has 150 spaces. Midway's lot has 90.

Aviation Commissioner Nuria Fernandez says she believes the lots will reduce congestion in the core around the airports' terminals and make the area safer for traffic.
